Supply List Most any art supply or office supply retailer will carry these supplies: Staples, Office Max, Michael's, University Art, Dick Blick, Utrecht or etc. The Mission College Book store should have most of these supplies.

- One 14" x 17" pad of smooth white drawing paper
- One 14" x 17" pad of **smooth, white**, 100# Bristol board.
- Four large sheets or small pack of of **true black** construction paper.
- One 18" metal ruler
- One large right triangle
- One each HB and 2B "artist quality" graphite drawing pencils.
- One box set of 12, Prismacolor color pencil set of 12 with primary colors.
- One soft White Plastic/Vinyl Eraser
- Rubber cement eraser
- One Black, disposable, .05, technical pen. (any brand will do I like Precise .05)
- One No.11 pen knife with extra blades or retractable utility knife.
- paint brushes one flat and one round (as per explanation)
- Set of **student grade** acrylic paints (black, white, medium green, and primary colors)
- One small roll of masking tape
- Small jar of rubber cement with application brush
- Presentation folder for Dossier / Portfolio (as per explanation)**Materials as needed from other sources** include, but not limited to:
 - One large roll of black duct tape ***do not get "Gorilla" tape**
 - White cloth 3'x5' finished (as per explanation)
 - clear objects, clear plastic sheets (as per explanation)
